



WHAT'S YOUR FLU SHOT PLAN?

5 ways to receive your flu vaccine:

- 1. On-Site Events:** These will be held at multiple locations across the system, with some events taking place at or nearby employee screening locations. Team members can also schedule one-on-one appointments with Employee Health.
- 2. Car-Side Events:** Team members will be able to schedule appointments at the Meyer Building at the Medical Center campus and at The Woodlands campus. Visit the flu website to schedule an appointment and review the car-side event guidelines.
- 3. Texas Children's Pediatrics with your Child:** Employees whose child or children receive care through a TCP practice will be eligible to receive their flu vaccine free of charge onsite during their

child's visit. When scheduling the appointment, the employee must inform the scheduler that they want to receive their vaccine and must bring their Texas Children's badge to the appointment.

- 4. Primary Care Provider (PCP):** For Texas Children's Employees enrolled in a Texas Children's medical plan through Cigna, the flu vaccine is covered at 100 percent when administered at your PCP's office.
- 5. Retail Pharmacies:** For Texas Children's Employees enrolled in a Texas Children's medical plan, the flu vaccine is covered at 100 percent when administered by an in-network pharmacy.
